Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes
October 10, 2023

Supervisor Reinbold called the meeting to order at 7:30pm with all board members present.

Bierlein moved to approve the September regular meeting minutes as presented. Huber supported. Motion carried.

Supervisor – Reported hall floors to be cleaned on 10/19/23 and the backflow connection will be tested.

Construction Code Group - Permits for September included 1 Building, 4 Electrical, 1 Mechanical, and 1 Plumbing.

Zoning Administrator - Submitted report. ZBA approved request from D. Erbsich for setback variance.

Code Enforcement – Submitted report.

Planning Commission – 4th Quarter meeting will be held 12/4/23.

Fire Chief – Runs for September included 1 PI. Training was Cascade System / Tender Dump Tank Operations and Fire Foam Induction.

The Annual Trunk or Treat will be held at the Blumfield Township Fire Department on October 31st from 6:30 – 8:00. Residents are encouraged to participate in handing out candy. Those wishing to participate in the handing out of cand. are asked to be at the FD at 6:00 and plan for 100-150 children.

Reese – Runs for September included 2 Medical and 1 Fire.

Clerk - Audit is in progress. Mandatory training and Monthly County workshops will begin this month to help us prepare for the Early Voting.

Treasurer – Finishing up Summer Tax collection. Audit is in progress.

Trustees – Huber reported MMWA cost estimates for 2024. Member deposits will be investigated by Daenzer.

Bierlein reported work has begun to get the new cemetery software set up.

OLD BUSINESS:

The revised Burn Ordinance and Blight Ordinance was distributed for review. Changes to these and the Parking Ordinance are requested to be submitted by October 30th so that the changes can be submitted to all by November 1st. Decisions on these ordinances will be made at the November meeting. Meetings with the FD officers will begin to get scheduled.

NEW BUSINESS:

Roethlisberger moved to approve the PA116 request from D. Wendland. Huber supported. Motion carried.

Roethlisberger moved to adopt Resolution 2023-02 opposing legislation to preempt local control for the siting and permitting of utility-scale renewable facilities including solar, wind, and large-scale battery storage facilities. Daenzer supported. Motion carried.

Bierlein moved to approve presented check register 26947 - 26967, payroll, and monthly EFT's. Huber supported. Motion carried.
